4. The house-number of the person who called on a Saturday multiplied by Annette's is that of the person who visited Annette.
5. The house-number of the person who called about repairing the organ donations multiplied by Suzanne's is that of the person who plays tennis. This is either Anne or Anneke (who visited Mrs Smiths).
6. The householder at number 21 was not too pleased when her sister spilt coffee all over the armchair - one day after she herself had been visiting.
